6. Look, talk and guess!

Dieses Arbeitsblatt schult sowohl die Sprachkompetenz, als auch das Hörverständnis der Schülerinnen und Schüler. Die Aufgabe der Heranwachsenden ist es, in Partner- oder Klassenarbeit ein Bild zu beschreiben. Die Mitschülerinnen und Mitschüler bzw. der Partner oder die Partnerin versuchen das Bild anhand der Beschreibung zu erkennen und die passende Nummer des Bildes zu nennen.

★ **Beispiel:** Kind 1 sagt: „*There is one elephant.*“ oder „*There are three lions.*“

Kind 2 sucht das beschriebene Bild und antwortet: „*It's picture number one.*“

Kind 1 bestätigt dies oder verneint dies.

Geben Sie als Hilfestellung die Phrasen „*There is one / There are*“ sowie auch „*It's picture...*“ vor.

Die Auseinandersetzung mit der Anzahl der Zootiere lädt zudem dazu ein, sich mit der Einzahl und Mehrzahl in der englischen Sprache zu beschäftigen. Die Kinder dürfen herausfinden und verstehen, dass in der Mehrzahl der Buchstabe „s“ an das Wort (Nomen) angehängt wird. Es gibt auch Ausnahmeregelungen oder die Anwendung von Apostrophen, diese ist allerdings für den Gebrauch des Vokabulars der Zootiere nicht wesentlich.
