

### Lunch at school

#### Read and then answer - PART 1

Here in Sweden school lunch is free for all students. There are a variety of meals that students can choose from. The food is usually healthy and there is always a vegetarian dish, too. The canteen very often serves fresh fish. The students don't get burgers or French fries at the canteen because this is considered to be unhealthy by the school board. The students can choose from a variety of drinks, too. But no coke because coke contains too much sugar and caffeine. For dessert the canteen offers sliced fruits, fruit salad and bagels. The students cannot buy sweets at the school's canteen. So if they want sweets they have to bring them from home.

Thomas, Sweden

In Vietnam schools don't offer meals at school. Children always bring their own lunches to school. Their parents prepare them at home and the students eat their packed lunches in their classrooms during the lunch break. The meals are home-cooked and are usually rice with vegetables and sometimes meat. The students can buy drinks at school but most students bring their own drinks from home, too. This is not so expensive. They also bring their own desserts. And sometimes they share their desserts with their friends or exchange their dishes.



